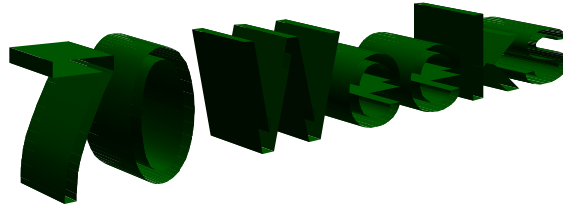


Daniel's Vision of the



Prophecy

1. Daniel's 70 weeks of prophecy began with a dream by Nebuchadnezzar; king of Babylon.
2. Nebuchadnezzar's dream was of a great metallic man, sometimes known as Colossus.
3. After the Wise Men of the kingdom could not tell the king his dreams, nor the interpretation, he called upon Daniel.
4. Daniel and his companions went to prayer and in the night, a vision came to Daniel.
5. This vision revealed to Daniel the king's dream of the Image – and the interpretation of it.
6. The image had a head of Gold, Breast of Silver, Thighs of Brass, Legs of Iron, and Feet of Iron and Clay.
7. One thing we learn from this is that there were to be Four Gentile Kingdoms to rule the world. (Dan. 2:38-40)
8. Another thing we learn is that they will diminish in value.
9. Daniel tells Nebuchadnezzar that he (or Babylon) is the head of Gold. (Dan. 2:38)
10. The second kingdom of Silver was to be the Medio-Persia.
11. The third kingdom of Brass was to be Greece.
12. The fourth and final kingdom of Iron was to be the Roman Empire.
13. The strength of these four Empires was to increase, as Gold to Iron.
14. The four Empires were also represented as four beasts. (Dan 7:)
15. The first Empire, Babylon was represented as a Lion.
16. The second Empire, Medio-Persia was represented as a Bear.
17. The third Empire, Greece was represented as a Leopard.
18. The fourth Empire, Roman was represented as a dreadful, terrible, wild Beast of seven heads and ten horns.
19. The first Empire falls on the night of Belshazzar's feast, where Daniel was called to read the handwriting on the wall. (Dan 5:30)
20. While they feasted, Medio-Persia diverted the river and sent the armies through the dry bed under the wall.

21. The Lion depicts the strongest of beasts, and had Eagle wings, the king of birds. Babylon was a great Empire.
22. The Bear (Medio-Persia) had three ribs in its mouth, shows the devouring of these nations who tried to stop its rise to world dominion; the "Triple-Alliance" of Lydia, Babylon and Egypt.
23. The Leopard had four heads, which represented the four generals who ruled quarters of the Empire under Alexander the Great of Greece.
24. The fourth beast had iron teeth that broke in pieces.
25. Its 10 horns correspond to its ten toes of Iron and Clay.
26. These ten toes, Daniel tells us, represents the Kingdoms.
27. Therefore, we understand that in the end of this Empire, ten kings will arise.
28. There are now Ten States of Europe.
29. These follow the boundaries of the Old Roman Empire.
30. It is from these Ten Kingdoms the Anti-Christ arises and gains power by first conquering three others.
31. The Horns connect this prophecy directly to the Anti-Christ in Revelation. (Rev. 13 and 17)
32. Chapter VII gives us a further description of Two Kingdoms.
33. Medio-Persia is here depicted as a Ram.
34. The Ram is overthrown by a He-Goat, or Greece.
35. The He-Goat first is seen as having One notable horn.
36. But, after conquering the Ram, the notable horn is broken and replaced with four horns.
37. This is the same interpretation as the four heads of the Leopard, or the four ruling generals of Greece, at the death of Alexander.
38. These four kingdoms were absorbed into the Roman Empire.
39. Egypt was the last to fall, 30 B.C.
40. The little horn which arises out the four – reveals to us Antiochus Epiphanes (Preview of antichrist) Dan.8:9
41. He is a forerunner or a preview of the Anti –Christ.
42. Many Bible scholars believe the Anti-Christ must be a Syrian-Jew.
43. This also relates to the Kingdom of the North. Daniel, Chapter 11.
44. It also corresponds to the little horn that arises from the ten and first conquerors four.
45. This, we know, depicts the rise of the Anti-Christ himself in the Fourth Kingdom's Toes, or the Revived Roman Empire. (Dan.7:8)
46. In Chapter nine, we have the formula for Daniel's Seventy weeks of Prophecy.
47. This prophecy concurs only Israel, for the prophecy was to be for "his people or Jews.
48. The Seventy-Weeks are divided into three periods in verses 24-27.
49. The first period is 7 weeks, for the rebuilding of Jerusalem.
50. The second period is 62 weeks unto the coming and cutting-off of the Messiah.

51. The third period is the 70th Week, which is Jacob's trouble. Jeremiah 30:7
52. The time of Daniel's 70 weeks was to begin with the "Going forth of the Commandment to rebuild and restore Jerusalem" Neh.2, B.C. 445.
53. Adding 445 B.C. to 29 A.D. we have 474 years and dividing by 69, we see each week of this prophecy is 7 years.
54. We understand it took 49 years to rebuild Jerusalem, 7 weeks x 7 years. (Neh.)
55. Ezekiel 4:6 – one week = 7 days, one day = one year; or (one week = 7 years)
56. Jacob worked seven years for Rachel. However, it was called one week. (Gen.29:27)
57. Therefore, we understand the 70th week shall be seven years.
58. However, we understand that this week or seven years does not happen until after the church is raptured, for Daniel never saw the Church but only the Jews.
59. The gap between the 69th and 70th week actually takes in this whole dispensation (2000 years).
60. Hosea 6:2, "after two days" will he raise up the Jews, and the "third day" they shall live in His sight.
61. II Peter 3:8, "one day is with the Lord as a thousand years."
62. Therefore, we know the Gap between the cross and the Great Tribulation, or the 69th and 70th week is actually 2,000 years.
63. Daniel tells us (9:27) the Anti-Christ shall make a covenant with Israel for one week, but he shall break it in the middle of the week.
64. We know the time of the Rapture is nigh for many reasons.
65. One way is Matthew 24 "When these signs begin (fig tree) they shall all be fulfilled in one Generation.
66. A generation in Matthew 1:17 is calculated as 37 years to 60 years.
67. Israel raised her flag again in 1948.
68. The end of these things would be fulfilled –1948 + 37 =1983 or at the most 1948 + 60 =2008.
69. In addition, we realize the Rapture takes place 7-14 years prior to this ending.
70. Therefore the Rapture would be calculated: 1983 – 7 = 1976 or 1983 – 14 = 1969 or at most,
2008 – 7 = 2001 or 2008 – 14 = 1994
71. Also, we know the church age was to be 2 days or 2000 years.
72. A.D. 32
+ 2000 but the difference between the Roman calendar and Jewish
2032 calendar is 5 days a year, so depending upon the date starting
– 28 the calculations are only guesses. 365 – 360 = 5 days, 2032 x
2004 5 days = 10,160 days, divide 10,160 by 365 days = approx.
